Explanation of the Position

The Bowls WA Academy has been fostering up and coming bowlers, both metropolitan and country, for the past six years.

After a review of the Bowls WA High Performance structure it has been decided a dedicated Bowls WA Academy Coach is required to take Talent Identification and Development to the next level.

The Bowls WA Academy Coach will work closely with the Talent Development Coordinator, State Selection Panel Chairperson and the Open State Team Coaches to provide a program to fast track future High Performance Players to the next level.

Key Tasks

To select, in consultation with the State Selection Panel Chairperson, the squad of players for which you are responsible for.

Implement player development strategies including, but not limited to, group coaching days and individual skill sessions.

To liaise with the Talent Development Coordinator in submitting coaching plans including but not limited to, on green and off green drills, use of past and present players as presenters and mentors and off green sports science.

To keep a coaching log of team and individual training including drill results and any other recordable and relevant information for future selection in WA High Performance teams.



In Consultation and Cooperation with the State Selection Panel Chairperson and Talent Development Coordinator provide both verbal and written feedback to individual Academy Squad members on their current progress on a six monthly basis.

- Current or working towards Club Coach Accreditation
- Current Working with Children Check
- Current Drivers Licence
- Computer Literate with access to personal email and internet
- Ability to communicate, work with and improve the skill level of prospective State Team Members
- Ability to work with other Coaches, Selectors and BWA Staff in a cohesive fashion
