1. OPEN MEETING: Chair Vince Del Prete opened the meeting at 8.00am.

6. BUSINESS ARISING:

6.1 Club Development – Winning Drive program

AD/KT advised that Bowls Link sessions were completed for both Club Administrators and Pennant Administrators across all country leagues.

AD/KT advised that a handful of clubs had completed Club Committee Compliance courses.

AD/CA to consider a Volunteer Management course for clubs.

6.2 Bowls Link

AD advised a number of issues had caused significant communication between Clubs/Leagues and Bowls WA however these would hopefully resolve over the following months with continued support and system upgrades.

Bowls Link training videos would be developed in the areas that need most support.

A continued summary of the progress of Bowls Link as follows:

- Weekly phone conferences with Bowls Link Working Party;
- Almost 100% attendance by Metro clubs and greater than 75% attendance by Country Clubs for Bowls Link courses;
- Continued training and support for clubs/leagues would be a priority leading into Pennants.
- Continual monthly upgrades for Bowls Link would further enhance the system.

Action- AD to report regularly on further progress.

6.3 Gotta Love the Bowlo Videos

AD advised that no videos had been produced in recent months and negotiations with Russell Woolf had broken down. The CDC resolved to consider Brad Hogg Ex Australian International Cricketer who had recently taken up bowls as a replacement on a similar agreement.

Actions- AD to contact Brad Hogg's management regarding an Ambassadorial role for the Association.

6.4 Gotta Love the Bowlo Radio Campaign

AD advised that the campaigns had been agreed to with the respective Media/Radio stations and would proceed in late Oct/November as per the briefs provided.

6.5 Club Development Charter

The CDC reviewed the existing charter and agreed no changes were necessary.
