All New Marker, Measurer and National Umpire applicants will be sent the new "Officiating Manual for Markers, Measurers & Umpires", as well as preliminary documentation outlining the learning outcomes expected for the level applied for.

All applicants will be required to provide their own '**Laws of the Sport Of Bowls, Crystal Mark Edition, v 3.1 April 2019**' (A number of the Law books will be available at the Sessions @ \$9.00)

The current Officiating Course is based upon active participation and continuing assessment, so all aspirants **must attend all relevant Sessions** to be accredited. Anyone aspiring only to Marking, Measuring or re-accrediting as Measurer may attend all sessions as observers if they wish. New **Umpires** MUST attend & accredit at ALL 3 sessions. It is advisable that, prior to attending, everyone should peruse the relevant chapters in the Manual which they must bring to any session/s.
