Below is a short list of those things Bowls WA does for you...

1. Bowls WA provides and coordinates programs that foster and promote the sport of lawn bowls to the whole community.
2. Bowls WA Coordinates State Championships, Country Week Championships and Junior Championships
3. Bowls WA promotes the Gotta Love the Bowlo Club Marketing and Advertising campaign designed to increase membership of all types within clubs.
4. Bowls WA conducts major International, National and State events that enhance the public profile of lawn bowls. This in turn increases membership through public interest.
5. Bowls WA provides clubs and their members with a professionally run Administration Office with efficient and friendly staff on hand for immediate assistance.
6. Bowls WA in conjunction with Bowls Australia and other STA's provides and supports the Bowls Connect Whole of Sport IT System which includes membership database, websites and competition and event management systems.
7. Bowls WA provides access to programs that develop quality assured and accredited coaches, accredited umpires and highly skilled volunteers
8. Bowls WA affiliation enables the access of clubs to the State Government Community Sporting and Recreation Facilities Fund
9. Bowls WA protects the interests of bowling clubs by representations to the State Government and regulatory bodies on matters affecting clubs
10. Bowls WA coordinates the Metropolitan Pennant Competition and, through the Country League, the Country pennant competition and provides all necessary materials for the events.
11. Bowls WA provides access for club development in conjunction with Bowls Australia through the Regional Bowls Manager Program, and an online Club Resource Guide.
12. Bowls WA provides member communication via the colourful and informative quarterly magazine "Jack Hi", a fortnightly e-newsletter, a dedicated website and social media.
13. Bowls WA provides registered bowlers with the opportunity to be selected in the state and national teams
14. Bowls WA organises social events to facilitate goodwill amongst bowlers- e.g. Veterans day.
15. Bowls WA rewards excellence at our Awards Night with players, clubs and volunteers recognized and awarded annually.
16. Bowls WA is continually updating the rules and regulations of the sport to ensure you gain the maximum enjoyment and pleasure from the game.
17. Bowls WA provides you with the opportunity to participate in the administration of the sport at club, regional, state or national level.
