6. BUSINESS ARISING:

6.1 Club Development – Winning Drive program

AD advised all scheduled training had now been completed. CA had attended the Goldfields league whilst Pilbara (CA) and Esperance (SU) would be visited in the next 6 months. AD advised a new round of funding was now available through Every Club Grants to assist the Winning Drive Program. The key details being the current grant to be acquitted by October 31st, the new Grant to be applied for by November 9th with the amount being from \$5f to \$15k for two calendar years.

The CDC agreed BWA should proceed with the acquittal and application and look to include some new aspects to the program. Some of these were discussed and are included in the Task List.
