Due to the 2nd AND 3rd Division Colour winners having differing numbers of Byes, the following method from the Metropolitan Pennant Competition – General Conditions was used to determine final rankings.

10.3 Inequality of byes between colours when determining rankings for Pennant Finals

10.3.1 2nd Division and below that take part in Pennant Finals

- (i) If one or more colours have byes during the home and away season meaning they play less games than other colours in the division, the Bowls WA Fixtures and Events Committee will determine the points and percentage allocation to the effected teams to bring them in line with the amount of games played in other colours at the end of the home and away season, these points and percentage will be added or subtracted to the clubs total .
- (ii) The points and percentage allocation will be determined using the following formula

Points – the average number of points gained per week by the relevant team over the course of the home and away season will be added to the team’s total points. If more than one bye needs to be compensated for, the average number of points added to the final total will be multiplied by the number of byes.

Percentage – the average percentage gained or lost per week over the course of the home and away season will be added or subtracted to the club’s total.
